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6 The classes, or regional or other groups, of members that the corporation is authorized to establish

The Corporation is authorized to establish two classes of members as follows: The Neighbourhood Group Members and Partner Members shall be entitled to receive notice of and to attend all meetings of the members of the corporation. Neighbourhood Group Members shall each have two (2) votes at each such meeting, and Partner Members shall each have one (1) vote at each such meeting.

7 Statement regarding the distribution of property remaining on liquidation

Any property remaining on liquidation of the corporation, after discharge of liabilities, shall be distributed or disposed of to one or more charities in Canada that are registered as such under the Income Tax Act (Canada) or equivalent designation under such legislation, and have similar charitable purposes to those of the Corporation at the time of liquidation, provided that any special or restricted charitable purpose trust funds held by the Corporation shall be transferred to one or more new trustee(s) that are charities in Canada that are registered as such under the Income Tax Act (Canada) and have been appointed by the directors of the Corporation to be applied in accordance with the applicable terms of trust.

8 Additional provisions, if any

- (a) The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in furtherance of its purposes.
- (b) Directors shall serve without remuneration, and no director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit from his or her position as such, provided that a director may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in performing his or her duties.
- (c) The Partner Members shall not be entitled to vote separately as a class or group on an amendment, or proposal to make an amendment, to: (i) effect an exchange, reclassification or cancellation of all or part of the memberships of such class; or (ii) create a new class or group of members having rights equal or superior to those of the Partner Members
